



RoHS Compliant Certification

Aztec Washer Company (Aztec) certifies that all products manufactured and sold at present time are compliant with a new directive (EU) 2015/863 that amended annex II to EU RoHS 2 (Directive 2011/65/EU) known as the new RoHS Directive for Hazardous Substances as published in the official Journal of the European Union on January 7, 2011 and amended on June 4, 2015.

“**RoHS Compliant**” means that the product or part does not contain any of the following restricted substances in excess of the following maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials, unless the substance is an application that is exempt under RoHS:

- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): Max 0.1%
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP): Max 0.1%
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): Max 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): Max 0.1%
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)

* Note: the following maximum limits by weight apply for lead used as alloying element:

- In Steel.....0.35% by weight
- In Aluminum.....0.35% by weight
- In copper alloys.....0.35% by weight
